3. Why you believe On Track Together to be a suitable opportunity for them.
4. A description of their personality, and rating of their interpersonal and social skills.
5. Your perception of their desire to learn, grow and receive input from others.
6. Any further comments or concerns you may have particularly in the following areas:
 - Family and church support for their participation
 - General well-being
 - Resilience and ability to cope living in a new environment overseas
 - Appropriateness of behaviour towards children*
 - Appropriateness of behaviour among those of the same or different gender
 - Attitude to authority figures
